



Youth Presentation Evaluation

In February, March, April, and May 2014, we conducted presentations about volunteering at various schools in Airdrie:

Bert Church High School Grade 10
Our Lady Queen of Peace Grade 6 & 8
Meadowbrook Middle School Grade 5, 6, 7, & 8
Good Shepherd Grade 5, 7, & 8
St Martin de Porres' all Grades

We collected over 250 completed surveys from the students:

61% of the students surveyed are NOT currently volunteering

Asked students if they believe they can make a difference in the community by volunteering:

42% chose "All the time" 26% chose "Often" 24% chose "Sometimes"
6% chose "Seldom" 1% chose "Never"

92% of the students said our presentation made them recognize the benefits of volunteering

95% of the students said they learned more about VA after seeing the presentation

When asked where the students would like to volunteer in Airdrie, the top 5 responses were:

1. Animal Shelter 2. Genesis Place 3. Food Bank 4. Sports 5. Bethany Care Centre

51% of the students said they would consider being a Youth Volunteer Team Leader
